Violated PA Election Code and PA Public Employee Relations Act by using members' dues to make a contribution to a political candidate or party.

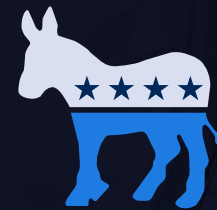
Fund for Student Success:

Contributed \$1,475,000 to the Democratic Governors Association



Violated PA Election Code by failing to register as a political committee.

Violated the U.S. Internal Revenue Code by submitting a fraudulent tax return.

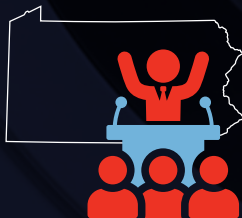


Democratic Governors Association:

Contributed \$7.2 million to Shapiro for Pennsylvania



Violated the PA Election Code by failing to disclose receipt of the contributions from the Fund for Student Success.

Spent the contributions on Josh Shapiro's gubernatorial bid
