



OUT OF TOUCH: THE HYPER-PARTISAN POLITICS OF THE MISSOURI NATIONAL EDUCATION ASSOCIATION

INTRODUCTION

Teachers unions in Missouri are generally affiliated with the Missouri National Education Association (MNEA) or the American Federation of Teachers Missouri (AFT Missouri), which are respectively affiliated with, and derive their names from, the two largest teachers unions in the country, the National Education Association (NEA) and the American Federation of Teachers (AFT).

The NEA and AFT are among the nation’s biggest political players, and their influence is not limited to education policy. Nationally, the NEA and AFT support everything from Critical Race Theory¹ to abortion² to gun control³ to efforts to defund the police,⁴ and oppose election integrity⁵ and policies seeking to preserve and protect women’s sports.⁶ As the *Wall Street Journal*’s editorial board put it, “The NEA and AFT have become the ideological and institutional vanguard of progressive politics. They are a powerful wing of the Democratic Party...”⁷

In Missouri, the AFT operates primarily through a few local affiliates in and around St. Louis and Kansas City, while the MNEA’s presence is felt more broadly across the state. Consequently, the MNEA has also declared itself to be the “state voice” of education in Missouri politics,⁸ has made “political action fundraising” one of its top priorities,⁹ and spares no expense in its aggressive push to reshape the political landscape of the state.

For instance, though it has fewer members than the independent, non-union Missouri State Teachers Association (MSTA),¹⁰ the MNEA boasts *four* statewide political action committees¹¹ to the MSTA’s *one*¹² and, with the help of the national NEA, spent over *15 times more* than the MSTA on electoral campaign activity between 2017 and 2024.¹³

Yet with a Republican governor and GOP supermajorities in both houses of the Missouri General Assembly, the MNEA undoubtedly strives to appear more balanced and bipartisan than its progressive national affiliate. For instance, the MNEA’s website boasts that it represents the political interests of “Democrats, Republicans, and Independents” and touts its endorsement process as one “that evaluates candidates based on their values, not party affiliation.”¹⁴

In reality, a review of campaign finance data reported to the Missouri Ethics Commission (MEC)¹⁵ by the MNEA, NEA and their associated political action committees shows that, from 2017-2024, the MNEA’s election spending almost exclusively benefitted Democrats. Tellingly, the MNEA’s only notable support registered across the aisle were its efforts to defeat *other* Republicans in certain GOP primaries. In addition, the MNEA and NEA devoted significant election spending to advance primarily Democrat-supported outcomes in high profile ballot fights over legislative redistricting and right-to-work laws.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

- \$3,949,599.13 (83.9 percent) of the \$4,706,332.71 spent by the MNEA and NEA in Missouri elections went to support Democrat or Democrat-aligned candidates, political committees, organizations, and primarily Democrat-supported ballot measures.
- Total support for GOP candidates and GOP-aligned political committees made up just 8.1 percent of total MNEA/NEA election spending. However, of that amount:
 - At least 87.8 percent was for the *only* apparent purpose of defeating other Republicans in certain GOP primaries; of those identified races, the MNEA spent just \$500 supporting one Republican in the resulting general election.
- The MNEA only expended funds for GOP candidates in races where a Republican won the general election by an average margin of 42.8 percentage points or ran unopposed.
- In every legislative race decided by a margin of less than 10 percentage points, the MNEA exclusively funded Democrats.
- In 2017-2018:
 - The NEA spent \$1 million and the MNEA spent \$500,846.54 to advance the ‘Clean Missouri’ redistricting, campaign finance and lobbying ballot initiative. Together, the MNEA and NEA were the initiative committee’s largest source of funds.
 - The MNEA spent \$100,000 backing the referendum on the legislature’s 2017 right-to-work law. Half of this came even after the law would have no longer affected the MNEA.¹⁶
- In 2020:
 - The NEA and MNEA again gave a combined \$1.7 million to the ‘Clean Missouri’ campaign opposing Amendment 3, the legislatively referred, GOP-led reversal of the 2018 redistricting changes.

THE MNEA PLAYBOOK: SUPPORT SAFE (OR STRATEGIC) REPUBLICANS, BUT FUND COMPETITIVE DEMOCRATS AND BALLOT MEASURES

From 2017-2024, the MNEA provided financial support to 40 Republican candidates for state legislature or statewide office.

However, of the \$382,391.84 spent by the MNEA’s political action committees over the past seven years for the ostensible purpose of supporting Republicans, \$231,071 was spread between just three primary election

campaigns, two of which were razor-thin races in which the MNEA-supported GOP candidate lost by a margin of less than two percentage points.¹⁷ Tellingly, none of the Republican candidates in the resulting general election received any financial support from the MNEA. Meanwhile, another \$100,000 of the MNEA's total expenditures for GOP candidates went to a political action committee devoted solely to influencing the Republican primary for Senate District 33 in 2020,¹⁸ a race decided by just 0.4 percentage points.

Whether tipping the scales in a GOP primary or not, the MNEA *only* supported Republicans in races where the odds of a Democrat victory were negligible. Of the 40 races in which GOP candidates received any election funding from the MNEA, nine featured general elections in which the Republican ran unopposed, and in all others, the Republican candidates prevailed over their Democrat opponents by an average margin of 42.8 percentage points.

In other words, at least 87.8 percent of the MNEA's total election spending for Republican candidates between 2017 and 2024 involved campaigns where the MNEA's *only* apparent motivation was to spoil certain Republicans' primary chances and propel other candidates of their choosing into general elections where a GOP victory was all but guaranteed. Otherwise, the remaining amount spent by the MNEA to support GOP candidates during this period made up just one percent of the total election spending by the MNEA and NEA.

But in swing districts, it's a different story.

In every legislative district where the margin of victory was less than 10 percentage points, the MNEA exclusively funded the Democrat candidate in the general election. More than half of these races were decided by less than 5 percentage points, and the average margin of victory was just 4.8 percent.

Additionally, the MNEA and NEA together spent millions of dollars trying to change Missouri's political map in an apparent move to help more Democrats get elected. In the 2017-18 election cycle, the MNEA and NEA spent more than \$1.5 million to advance the 'Clean Missouri' ballot initiative (Amendment 1), a multi-subject constitutional amendment that included sweeping changes to Missouri's legislative redistricting process characterized by Republican leaders as an underhanded attempt to win Democrats more seats in the statehouse.¹⁹ The backers of Clean Missouri, for their part, lobbed their own gerrymandering accusations at Republicans and, when the GOP-controlled legislature subsequently referred Amendment 3 to the voters in 2020—the passage of which successfully reversed the changes made in 2018—the MNEA and NEA again bankrolled Clean Missouri's opposition campaign to the tune of \$1.7 million.

Together, the MNEA and NEA were Clean Missouri's largest source of funds, outspending the committee's next highest contributor by a total of \$928,846.54 across both election years.²⁰

All told, 83.9 percent of the total election spending by the MNEA and NEA between 2017 and 2024 went to support Democrat candidates, the state Democrat party apparatus, Democrat-aligned candidates running for nonpartisan office, and Democrat-supported political committees and ballot measures.

Not to be overlooked, a significant amount was also spent by the MNEA's political action committees for the purpose of funding school board elections across Missouri. Often featuring a slate of candidates vying for multiple open positions, school board races are commonly close affairs. Of the 230 MNEA-funded school board elections from 2017-2024 for which results could be found, 71.3 percent were decided by less than 10 percentage points, and the average margin of victory was just 8.6 percentage points. In total, the MNEA spent \$224,305.24 to influence school board races during this period. Not only does the MNEA negotiate union contracts with the very board members whose campaigns it funds, but, though school board positions are officially nonpartisan, the MNEA's overwhelming support for state-level Democrat candidates and causes lends reasonable belief that it likely backs politically or at least ideologically aligned school board candidates whenever possible.

The data reveal a clear playbook: the MNEA backs a small number of GOP candidates in strategic primary elections in an apparent attempt to claim bipartisanship and curry favor with key players of Missouri's Republican legislative majority, while simultaneously spending heavily to shrink or eliminate it.

USING MEMBERS' DUES FOR POLITICS

On its website, the MNEA makes the misleading claim that, "Money for political activity comes from voluntary contributions."²¹

However, while the MNEA does solicit voluntary contributions for its various political committees, much of its election spending between 2017 and 2024 was actually derived from members' dues payments, *not* their voluntary political contributions.

As recently as December 2023, the MNEA's online membership enrollment form indicated that the union automatically transferred a portion of every member's dues payment into the union's statewide political action and ballot measure committees.²² Though the MNEA's form described these payments as "voluntary contributions," members were automatically opted into making the contribution unless they proactively reduced the default amount to \$0. Similar arrangements, commonly referred to as "reverse check-off," are strictly prohibited under federal election laws.²³

Additionally, their affiliation with the NEA requires the MNEA and its local affiliates to send a portion of the dues collected from Missouri teachers to the NEA headquarters in Washington, D.C. For instance, during the 2023-24 school year, \$208 of the annual dues paid by each full-time MNEA member went to the NEA.²⁴

The NEA's annual financial reports to the U.S. Department of Labor disclose that about 10-20 percent of the funds spent by the NEA in a typical year are for "political activities and lobbying,"²⁵ some of which involves Missouri elections.

In the 2023-24 school year alone, the NEA gave \$196,000 in "ballot initiative support grants" to the MNEA.²⁶ Additionally, that same year the NEA contributed \$18.9 million to the NEA Advocacy Fund,²⁷ a dues-funded

political committee.²⁸ According to campaign disclosure reports filed with the MEC by Taxpayers in Support of Public Education (TISPE), one of the four political action committees that the MNEA operates,²⁹ the NEA Advocacy Fund gave \$85,000 to TISPE between January and November 2024—*more than 7 times the amount of voluntary member contributions received during the same period by all four of the MNEA’s political action committees combined.*³⁰

Finally, out of the more than \$3.2 million spent by the NEA and MNEA bankrolling ‘Clean Missouri’ in the 2018 and 2020 elections, at least \$3,000,846.54 (94 percent) came directly out of the unions’ general treasury funds (i.e., members’ dues), *not* their political action committees.³¹

Laundering money through the NEA allows the MNEA to suggest that it doesn’t use members’ dues for politics, but there’s no denying that members’ dues are indeed put to that purpose with the full knowledge of the MNEA.

GOVERNMENT COLLECTION OF TEACHERS UNION DUES

Teachers unions in Missouri benefit from multiple special privileges commonly secured in union contract negotiations, not least of which is the obligation of school districts to function as unions’ dues collector by deducting dues from teachers’ paychecks and transmitting the funds to the applicable union, including the MNEA.

Although not required by state law, Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.300 broadly permits school districts to provide various payroll deductions, including “membership dues” and “voluntary contributions,” from employees’ paychecks.³² While the law does not specify unions, payroll deduction of dues is a top priority for teachers unions, and the NEA specifically advises its affiliates to prioritize securing district-administered payroll deduction of union dues.³³

There is simply no public policy justification for using Missouri’s taxpayer-funded public payroll systems to collect dues and political contributions for one of the largest special interest groups in the state. Teachers unions like the MNEA should bear the administrative costs and burdens associated with collecting their own revenue.

Without government-run dues collection, unions like the MNEA would have to ask teachers not just for a signature, but to sign up for regular payments via credit card or electronic funds transfer from their bank account. And in fact, because some Missouri school districts have opted not to collect dues for unions, the MNEA already provides this option for some members.³⁴ This arrangement shifts the balance of power back to the employees, and codifying it into law would help ensure that teachers and other school employees only agree to sign up for union membership—and the associated political contributions—if they truly and voluntarily want to.

While unions like the MNEA would undoubtedly claim that ending payroll deduction of dues would impose hardships on employees, the reality is that the MNEA already offers this option in districts where payroll deduction is not currently available, and for school employees, signing up for union membership would be no more difficult than creating a Netflix account.

Other states are increasingly moving in this direction. In 2023 alone, Florida,³⁵ Arkansas,³⁶ Tennessee³⁷ and Kentucky³⁸ all ended government collection of dues for teachers unions.

CONCLUSION

Though the MNEA may at times endeavor to appear bipartisan to Missouri's GOP-led state legislature, the data reveals the opposite is true. In fact, the MNEA's approach appears to be one bent on eroding the GOP majority while buying itself enough political cover to claim that it represents the interests of Republicans and Democrats alike. Yet given the state's increasingly conservative political bent, it's unlikely that the MNEA's hyper-partisan political activity is representative of even its own members, let alone all Missourians impacted by the elections it disproportionately funds.

Given the First Amendment implications, Missouri's teachers and school employees deserve more control over their dues payments and political contributions so they can decide for themselves whether membership in the MNEA and NEA aligns with their values and interests. Further, Missouri policymakers would be better served by a comprehensive understanding of the MNEA's political influence and extreme partisanship when considering proposals to end taxpayer-funded handouts for teachers unions.

To better protect teachers' rights and prevent taxpayers from having to subsidize the politicking of unions like the MNEA, Missouri lawmakers should join the ranks of states taking steps to end government collection of union dues and similar taxpayer handouts for unions in public schools.
